

107th Avenue North Public Utilities Renewal Project

Dear Resident/Tenant and Business Owner of 107th Avenue North:

The Collier County Public Utilities Renewal Project team is pleased to inform you that our contractor will soon be connecting your home or business to the newly installed water main.

Things to know:

- 1) The process of connecting all homes and businesses on 107th Avenue North between Vanderbilt Drive and 8th Street is anticipated to start during the week of October 1, 2017, and will take approximately four weeks to complete.
- 2) Each individual connection will take approximately **one hour to connect and flush**, during which time your **water service will be interrupted**.
- 3) The contractor will knock on your door to let you know when your water service will be temporarily disconnected.
- 4) After the connection is completed, the contractor will need to flush the new water service pipe using a hose bib on the outside of the structure. If a hose bib is not available, the contractor may use alternate flushing methods. Businesses will receive a precautionary boil water notice following the connection to the new main.
- 5) The interruption in service could occur anytime during the hours of 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Saturday.
