



108th and 109th Avenues N Public Utilities Renewal

April 16, 2021

Dear residents of 108th and 109th Avenues N:

The project to replace the water, sewer, and stormwater infrastructure on 108th and 109th avenues is starting at the end of April 2021. Construction will take place over the next 15 months with both avenues being completed simultaneously. There are no special assessments associated with this work.

As part of the utility improvements, the contractor is replacing clay wastewater pipe with PVC pipe and may need to excavate into your property. To document that you have been advised of this work and that you authorize the County to work on your property, we request that you sign and return the Right of Entry (ROE) form attached.

Owners are receiving the ROE form in the mail and as a door hanger; please return just one. If the Right of Entry form is not returned, the contractor will not be able to connect your water and/or wastewater services and the property owner will be responsible for hiring a licensed plumber to make the connection to the new system.

Rehabilitation of the stormwater collection and treatment system will impact the right of way in front of your property. To ensure the stormwater infrastructure is properly installed, the contractor will remove all obstructions. This will generally include removal of trees, shrubs, and structures located in the right of way which is approximately 20 feet from edge of pavement to your property line. To facilitate this work, existing concrete, paver and asphalt driveways will be cut and then restored to pre-construction conditions. If there are landscape, irrigation or other structures in the right of way that you want to save, you are advised to start removing and relocating them.

To assist in completing your Right of Entry forms, the County will make available notaries as follows:
