110th Avenue North Paving Notice

February 14, 2018

Dear Residents of 110th Avenue North:

Collier County is pleased to announce that the first layer of pavement is tentatively scheduled to be begin on 110th Avenue North.

Saturday February 17th and Monday February 19th, 2018

(Subject to weather and unforeseen conditions)

The Contactor is anticipating completing the paving by block in the following sequence:

500 block of 110th Avenue North

700 Block of 110th Avenue North

600 block of 110th Avenue North

Roads must be cleared of personal vehicles and property during the paving activities for your block.

The following information is critical for successful completion of the paving work:

- Residents and all residential services will have limited access during the paving. Emergency vehicles will be given access as required.
- No personal vehicles or property shall be in the road or in the right-of-way between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m starting on Saturday February 17th and again on Monday, February 19th, until the paving is completed on your block. The Contractor will tow vehicles at the owner's expense. Personal property in the right-of-way will also be removed.
- Landscaping trucks, construction trucks or delivery trucks will not be able to park on the street or turn into driveways during paving. If one of these types of vehicles is in the road or in the Right-of-Way after 7:00 a.m. Saturday, February 17th or Monday, February 19th, , the Contractor will tow the vehicle at the owner's expense.
- Paving will be cancelled and rescheduled if weather prohibits paving activities, or for any other unforeseen conditions.
- Please be mindful and cautious of the wooden stakes along the road. Please do NOT disturb these stakes, as they are necessary for the Contractor to complete the paving work.
