

# Naples Park Public Utilities Renewal

July 7, 2016

Dear residents and business owners of 107<sup>th</sup> Avenue North, 110<sup>th</sup> Avenue North, and 8<sup>th</sup> Street North:

Collier County's Public Utilities and Growth Management Departments have completed the design to repair or replace the water, wastewater, and stormwater systems that serve 107<sup>th</sup> Avenue North and 110<sup>th</sup> Avenue North, and the wastewater system along 8<sup>th</sup> Street from 107<sup>th</sup> Avenue North to 111<sup>th</sup> Avenue North. These projects are necessary to ensure a continued high level of utility service for the community.

A neighborhood information meeting will be held

There will be a short presentation to provide overall project information, after which project team members will be available to answer questions.

The Public Utilities Department's Planning and Project Management Division expects to receive construction bids by the end of 2016, and then take the lowest qualified bid to the Board of County Commissions for approval. At that time, a second neighborhood information meeting will be held to introduce the Project Delivery Team, including the contractor, engineers, project managers, and inspectors, and to provide specific information about the project, including the general schedule and what you can expect during construction.

As part of the utility system improvements, the county's contractors will replace water and sewer service lines. If there is a clay pipe wastewater service lateral from your property to the gravity main in the street, a portion will be replaced with new PVC pipe. This may require excavating a short distance into your property. To document that you have been advised of this work and that you authorize the county to work on your property, we request that you sign and return the enclosed Right of Entry form. A return envelope is provided. Please note that the county will not replace the entire length of clay pipe that may be on your private property.

Rehabilitation of the stormwater collection and treatment system will impact the right-of-way in front of your property. To ensure the stormwater infrastructure is properly installed, the contractor will remove all interfering obstructions. This will generally include removal of trees, shrubs, and structures located in the right-of-way, which is approximately 30 feet from the center of the road to your property line. To facilitate this work, existing concrete and asphalt driveways will be cut then restored; pavers will be removed and re-install to pre-construction conditions. If there are landscape or other structures in the right-of-way you want to save, you are advised to start removing or relocating them now.
