

Vanderbilt Drive Cul-de-sacs Public Utilities Renewal

Neighborhood Information Meeting

Dear Residents of Vanderbilt Drive, Flamingo Avenue, Heron Avenue, Egret Avenue, Conners Avenue, Seabee Avenue, Germain Avenue, Seagull Avenue, Willet Avenue, Tradewinds Avenue, Lagoon Avenue, Bayside Avenue, Pine Avenue, Oak Avenue, and Palm Court:

Construction on the Vanderbilt Drive and Cul-de-sacs Water, Wastewater, and Stormwater Renewal Project is underway, concurrent with the Vanderbilt Drive Beautification MSTU Underground Cable Project. A neighborhood information meeting will be held on:

The purpose of the meeting is to update residents on the construction status. To integrate the utility project and the MSTU project into one schedule, the utility construction phases are changing to align with the MSTU electrical sections. Utility work on Phases 1 and 2 will continue, but in the next few weeks, the utility contractor will start an additional construction crew on the remainder of Vanderbilt Drive to complete it in the next six to eight months. After that, work will resume on the remaining finger streets.

The project delivery team members from the Collier County Public Utilities Engineering and Project Management Division and Collier County Public Transit & Neighborhood Enhancement Division (MSTU) will be present to address your questions and concerns.

- To assure that your new utilities are reconnected, please complete your right-of-entry form if you have not already done so. If you have misplaced your form, let us know and we will send another one.
- If you have personal items in the right-of-way, they will be removed during construction. If you wish to keep them, please remove prior to the contractor commencing work.
