Dear Residents of the 500 Block of 95th Avenue North:

PAVING UPDATE:

Unfortunately, soil/limerock conditions will not allow the placement of the first layer of asphalt today (March 29, 2019). The Contractor has rescheduled the placement of the first layer of asphalt pavement on the 500 block of 95th Avenue North for Monday, April 1, 2019. We apologize for the short notice and the rescheduling, but it is imperative that the soil/limerock conditions meet Collier County standards before the placement of asphalt pavement. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

500 Block First Layer of Pavement

When: Monday, April 1, 2019 from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM
Construction schedule is subject to weather conditions.
Right-of-Way must be cleared of any vehicles and property.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Paving activities will start at 7:00 AM
- Residents and all residential services will have limited access during the paving. Emergency vehicles will be given access as required.
- If a personal vehicle is on the road or in the right-of-way after 7:00 am on Monday, April 1, 2019 the contractor will tow the vehicle at the owner's expense. Personal property in the right-of-way will also be removed.
- Landscaping trucks, construction trucks or any delivery trucks will not be able to park on the road or turn into driveways during paving.
- Paving will be cancelled and rescheduled if weather prohibits paving activities as scheduled or for any unforeseen conditions.
- The contractor is anticipating commencing concrete and brick paver driveway installation immediately following the new pavement being placed

DRIVEWAY RESTORATION NOTES:

Following the placement of the first lift of asphalt on the 500 Block of 95th Avenue North, the Contractor will begin the restoration of driveways within the 500 Block. Concrete driveways will be restored first, followed by brick paver and asphalt driveway. Prior to restoration, project team members will be visiting each driveway to determine and mark the limit of driveway restoration. These markings are important for the Contractor during the driveway restoration process but are not permanent and will be removed during the restoration process. The Contractor will coordinate directly with each resident to facilitate the restoration of each driveway. Brick paver and asphalt driveway restoration typically require 1-2 days of access by the Contractor when residents cannot drive/park on the driveways. Concrete driveways require greater preparation and time as follows. Again, the Contractor will coordinate directly with each resident to facilitate the restoration of each driveway.

The following applies to concrete driveways only. Concrete driveways must be cleared of personal vehicles and property during the restoration process. The construction schedule and sequence is subject to weather conditions. The Contractor will be placing cones and caution tape to barricade the areas that they will work within for driveway restoration activities. While driveway restoration is occurring, we are advising residents to park along the road, in areas not barricaded off by the Contractor. If possible, please coordinate and plan to park in a neighbor's driveway.

The concrete driveway restoration process is as follows:

Day 1 – Prepare driveways for concrete (i.e. remove dirt and place formwork), no access to driveways

Day 2 – No access to driveways during forming, placing and setting of concrete

Day 3 thru Day 5 – Curing period, no access permitted

Day 6 – Access permitted 72 hours after concrete is poured (i.e. after the end of Day 5)

The Contractor's goal is to finish six (6) to ten (10) concrete driveways per day. It is not possible to provide an exact day of this process for each house, but field personnel will notify homeowners in advance by knocking on their doors.
