Collier County is pleased to announce that the first layer of asphalt pavement on the 800 block of 96th Avenue N. is scheduled to be completed as follows:

When: Friday, February 26 or Tuesday, March 2 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Construction schedule is subject to weather and field conditions.

Paving schedule changes will be posted to www.CollierPUR.com; no additional notices will be provided.

Right-of-way must be cleared of any vehicles and property.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- The paving is scheduled for Friday, February 26, 2021. If not completed then, paving will be on Tuesday, March 2, 2021. Please check www.CollierPUR.com for updates.
- Paving activities will start at 7:00 a.m.
- Residents and all residential services will have limited access during paving operations.
- Please give yourself extra time to complete your travel plans.
- Emergency vehicles will be given access.
- If a personal vehicle is on the road or in the right-of-way after 7:00 a.m. on paving day, the contractor will tow the vehicle at the owner's expense. Personal property in the right-of-way will also be removed.
- Landscaping trucks, construction trucks or any delivery trucks will not have access and will not be able to park on the road or turn into driveways during paving. Please notify them in advance.
- Paving will be canceled and rescheduled if weather prohibits paving activities as scheduled or for any unforeseen conditions.
