

# 96<sup>th</sup> Avenue North Public Utilities Renewal

## Paving Notice

March 24, 2021

Dear residents,

Collier County is pleased to announce that the second and final layer of pavement is scheduled to begin on 96<sup>th</sup> Avenue North on the following dates:

**When: Monday, March 29 and Tuesday, March 30, 2021**

**Construction schedule is subject to weather and field conditions.**

**Paving schedule changes will be posted to [www.CollierPUR.com](http://www.CollierPUR.com); no additional notices will be sent.**

**Right-of-Way must be cleared of any vehicles and property.**

### IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Paving activities will start at 7:00 a.m.
- Streets will be closed to **all** traffic to accommodate full-width paving which provides a better end-product.
- Residents and all residential services will have limited access during paving. Emergency vehicles will be given access as required.
- No personal vehicles or property shall be in the road or in the Right-of-Way between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. starting on March 29 and continuing daily until the paving is completed in your block. The contractor will tow vehicles at the owner's expenses. Personal property in the Right-of-Way will also be removed.
- Landscaping trucks, construction trucks or any delivery trucks will not have access and will not be able to park on the road or turn into driveways during paving. Please notify them in advance.
- Paving will be cancelled and rescheduled if weather prohibits paving activities as scheduled or for any unforeseen conditions. Please check [www.CollierPUR.com](http://www.CollierPUR.com) for updates.

Some residents may notice tire marks on their driveways from the fresh asphalt. These marks are unavoidable and will fade away after approximately 3 to 4 months. Residents may want to take precautionary measures to minimize tire marks. Collier County will not clean or replace driveways due to tire marking. Minimizing traffic will result in a better product and fewer tire marks.
