

110th Avenue North Public Utilities Renewal Project

Dear Resident/Tenant of 110th Avenue North,

The Collier County Public Utilities Renewal Project team is pleased to inform you that our contractor will soon be connecting your home/business to the newly installed water main.

Things to know:

- 1) The process of connecting all homes and businesses on 110th Ave North between Vanderbilt Drive and US 41 is anticipated to start during the week of 7/9/2017 and will take about four (4) weeks to complete.
- 2) Each individual residence/business will take about **1 hour to connect and flush**, during which time your **water service will be interrupted**.
- 3) The contractor will come to your door to let you know when your water service will be temporarily disconnected.
- 4) After the connection is completed, the contractor will need to flush your new water service pipe using a hose bib on the outside of your home or business. If a hose bib is not available, the contractor may use alternate flushing methods.
- 5) The interruption in service could occur anytime during the hours of 7am-7pm Monday through Saturday.
