

Vanderbilt Drive Cul-de-sacs Public Utilities Renewal

Dear Residents,

As you have noticed, construction of Phase 3 of the Vanderbilt Drive and Cul-de-sacs Water, Wastewater, and Stormwater Renewal Project has begun. Phase 3 (Vanderbilt 9100-10082) is scheduled to be complete April 2018. Restoration of driveways, right-of-ways, mailboxes and sprinklers is scheduled to occur between March and April 2018. The first layer of new asphalt is scheduled to be installed in March 2018.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- The safety of the residents and utility workers is of utmost importance.
- Due to the contractor's means and methods of construction, and to assure the safety of all, the contractor will need full access of the Right-of-Way (ROW).
- The contractor will be installing new water, sewer and stormwater lines.
- There will be lane closures and detours for through-traffic. Access for residents impacted by construction will be maintained.
- The contractor has staked the ROW for Phase 3. Please do not disturb or remove ROW stakes.
- In accordance with Collier County Ordinance 2009-19 and the *Right-of-Way Handbook*:
 - Everything in the ROW (driveway sections, grass, trees, shrubs, landscaping, ornamentation, structures, mail boxes and irrigation systems) is subject to removal during construction.
 - Regardless of any existing ROW permits, the contractor has the right to remove trees, shrubs, landscaping, ornamentation, and structures installed in the ROW in order to complete the project.
 - Existing trees, shrubs, landscaping, ornamentation, and structures within the ROW will not be replaced per Ordinance 2009-19.
- Electrical wires installed in the ROW by the residents will need to be de-energized by the owner for the safety of residents and workers.
- Existing irrigation systems in the ROW will be restored to ensure that new sod gets established. Driveways, grassed areas and mail boxes will also be restored as close to existing as possible.

WHAT RESIDENTS NEED TO DO

- Remove any items you wish to save from the ROW construction area. If you replant trees, shrubs, landscaping, ornamentation and structures, they should be located on your property outside of the ROW.
- Complete, notarize and return your Right-of-Entry form if you have not already done so. Right-of-Entry forms are required to reconnect your utility services.
