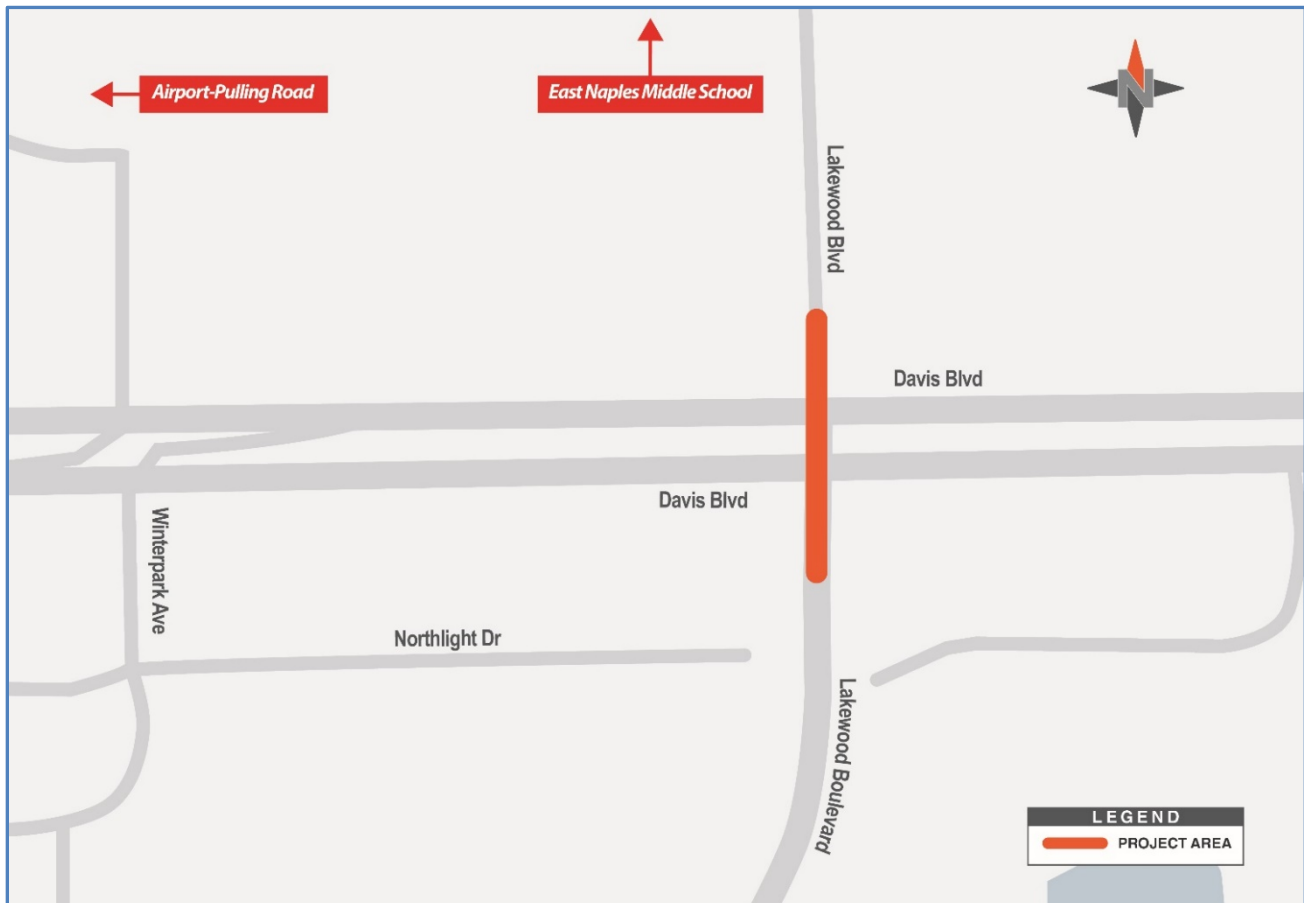


CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Underground drill work beginning soon

Collier County's contractor, *Quality Enterprises USA, Inc.*, will soon utilize an underground drill to install a new pressurized wastewater pipeline in the area highlighted in orange on the map below. This new pipeline, known as a force main, will provide additional resiliency, operational flexibility, and capacity to improve service reliability and meet projected demands throughout the area.

Staging of equipment followed by pipe installation is anticipated to begin the week of September 30 and is expected to end in mid-October. This work will be performed in the right of way and County Utility Easement (CUE). On some days, it is expected crews will work past 7 p.m. Occasional weekend work may also occur. Although this will be an active construction zone, every effort will be made to minimize inconveniences to you and your neighbors. Should temporary road closures be necessary, flaggers, safety signs, and/or detour signs will be present to assist drivers and pedestrians through the work area. **Please note: construction schedules and needs are often fluid; however, we will make every effort to keep you as informed as possible while the work progresses.**
