

Vanderbilt Drive Cul-de-sacs Public Utilities Renewal

Paving Notice Update

October 11, 2019

Dear Residents of Willet, Tradewinds, Lagoon, Bayside, Pine and Oak Avenues, Palm Court and Vanderbilt Drive from Vanderbilt Beach Road to 101st Avenue:

The purpose of this notification is to let you know that the contractor will put the second lift of asphalt on Vanderbilt Drive on Monday, October 14, 2019. This change is because the contractor needs to first repair the Naples Park Avenues adjacent to Vanderbilt Drive that were impacted by the project.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Paving activities will start at 7:00 a.m.
- Streets will be closed to all traffic to accommodate full-width paving which provides a better end-product.
- Please give yourself extra time to get in and out of your street while Vanderbilt is being worked on.
- Emergency vehicles only will be given access.
- If a personal vehicle is on the road or in the right-of-way after 7:00 a.m. on paving days, the contractor will tow the vehicle at the owner's expense. Personal property in the right-of-way will also be removed.
- Landscaping trucks, construction trucks or any delivery trucks will have no access and will not be able to park on the road or turn into driveways during paving. Please notify them in advance.
- Paving will be cancelled and rescheduled if weather prohibits paving activities as scheduled or for any unforeseen conditions.

Some residents may notice tire marks on their driveways from the fresh asphalt. These marks are unavoidable and will fade away after approximately 3 to 4 months. Residents may want to take precautionary measures to minimize tire marks. The County will not clean or replace driveways due to tire marking. Minimizing traffic will result in a better end product and less tire marks.
