Paving Notice Update

October 16, 2019

Dear Residents,

Due to a shortage of materials to prepare the asphalt mix, the first layer of pavement has been re-scheduled to **Thursday, October 24, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.** for Seabee Avenue, Vanderbilt Drive between 103rd and 106th Avenues, and 103rd Avenue North.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Paving activities will start at 7:00 a.m.
- Residents and all residential services will have limited access during the paving. Emergency vehicles will be given access as required.
- If a personal vehicle is on the road or in the right-of-way after 7:00 a.m. on **Thursday, October 24, 2019**, the contractor will tow the vehicle at the owner's expense. Personal property in the right-of-way will also be removed.
- Landscaping trucks, construction trucks or any delivery trucks will not be able to park on the road or turn into driveways during paving.
- Paving will be cancelled and rescheduled if weather prohibits paving activities as scheduled or for any unforeseen conditions.
