

## Vanderbilt Drive Cul-de-sacs Public Utilities Renewal

Dear Residents of Conners Avenue of Vanderbilt Drive Cul-de-sacs,

The Vanderbilt Drive Cul-de-sacs (VDC) project is now working on the final phases. This notification will update the residents on Conners Avenue on the status of completing their road improvements.

As many of you know, Conners Avenue was originally part of Phase 2 of the VDC project. New water lines were installed as part of Phase 2, and completed prior to Hurricane Irma on September 10, 2017. Due to the hurricane, significant washouts occurred on Vanderbilt Drive. This resulted in the VDC project being re-phased and Conners Avenue subsequently being moved to Phase 4A. Once the washouts were stabilized, the contractor again commenced work on the completion of Conners Avenue.

Currently, all the new utility pipes have been installed on Conners Avenue – water, sewer, and stormwater. The next step will require the contractor to construct the road bed in preparation for the first lift of asphalt. During the re-phasing, the contractor had scheduled the commencement of road work on Conners Avenue for the middle of March 2019. As of last week, the contractor was ahead of schedule and was going to start the road work on Conners Avenue the week of February 18, 2019. The Contractor just informed us that due to unforeseen conditions, the beginning of roadway restoration on Conners Avenue is now scheduled for the week of March 18, 2019.

We apologize for this unforeseen delay and appreciate the residents' patience while we complete these final phases of this project.
