## NEIGHBORHOOD INFORMATION MEETING NOTICE

We are pleased to announce that the Vanderbilt Drive and Cul-de-sacs Water, Wastewater, and Stormwater Renewal Project is approximately 60% complete, the MSTU electrical underground project is approximately 85% energized, and the four (4) impacted stormwater outfalls on the west side of Vanderbilt Drive are being restored. We are now beginning the final year of construction. To provide an update through the end of the project, a neighborhood information meeting will be held as follows:
