## Vanderbilt Drive Phase 1 Update

August 15, 2017

Dear Residents of Vanderbilt Drive, Flamingo Avenue, Heron Avenue, Egret Avenue, and Conners Avenue:

This notification is to provide an update regarding the paving of Vanderbilt Drive - Phase 1. The contractor experienced several conflicts with other utilities in that specific area. Some of the conflicts required relocating existing utilities to find a solution. Mitchell and Stark will implement all the required deviations to finish the installation of the storm water drainage and the road structure in the next four to six weeks, subject to weather conditions.

As you have noticed, this year has been one of the wettest in Collier County with record-breaking rainfall in June and a 200-year rain event in July. These weather events have obviously impacted the progress of the project.

Final paving of Vanderbilt Drive - Phase 1 is scheduled for September 2017, with final restoration in October 2017. We apologize for the inconvenience.

As soon as Phases 1 and 2 are completed, we will notify the residents about another Neighborhood Information Meeting to address the remainder of the project.
