

# Vanderbilt Drive Cul-de-sacs Public Utilities Renewal

## Vanderbilt Drive Paving Notice

March 27, 2018

Dear Residents of Vanderbilt Drive and Vanderbilt Beach Road:

Collier County is pleased to announce that the first layer of pavement is scheduled to be complete at the following locations:

- Vanderbilt Beach Road (from Vanderbilt Drive heading west)
- Vanderbilt Drive (south of 91<sup>st</sup> Avenue and between 94<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 96<sup>th</sup> Avenue)

**When: Friday, March 30, 2018 from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM**  
**Construction will be subject to weather conditions.**  
**Roads must be cleared of personal vehicles and property.**

### IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Paving activities will start on Vanderbilt Drive at 7:00am for 3 to 5 hours.
- Residents and all residential services will have limited access during the paving. Emergency vehicles will be given access as required.
- If a personal vehicle is in the road or in the right-of-way after 7:00am on Friday March 30, 2018 the contractor will tow the vehicle at the owner's expense. Personal property in the right-of-way will also be removed.
- Garbage pickup will be scheduled to start at 6:00 am on March 30, 2017.
- Landscaping trucks, construction trucks or any delivery trucks will not be able to park on the street or turn to driveways during paving.
- Paving will be cancelled and rescheduled if weather prohibits paving activities as scheduled or for any unforeseen conditions.
- After asphalt cures and the striping is completed, Vanderbilt Drive detour and Vanderbilt Beach Road lane diversion will no longer be in effect, tentatively the week of April 2, 2018.
