## Paving Notice

Dear Residents of Seagull Avenue, Germain Avenue, and Vanderbilt Drive,

Collier County is pleased to announce that the first layer of asphalt pavement is scheduled to be completed on Seagull Avenue, Germain Avenue and Vanderbilt Drive between 101<sup>st</sup> and 104<sup>rd</sup> Avenues N.

**When: Monday, September 30, 2019 from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM**  
**Construction schedule is subject to weather conditions.**  
**Right-of-Way must be cleared of any vehicles and property.**

### IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Paving activities will start at 7:00am.
- Residents and all residential services will have limited access during the paving. Emergency vehicles will be given access as required.
- If a personal vehicle is on the road or in the right-of-way after 7:00am on **Monday, September 30**, the contractor will tow the vehicle at the owner's expense. Personal property in the right-of-way will also be removed.
- Landscaping trucks, construction trucks or any delivery trucks will not be able to park on the road or turn into driveways during paving. Please notify them in advance.
- Paving will be cancelled and rescheduled if weather prohibits paving activities as scheduled or for any unforeseen conditions.
