

# Vanderbilt Drive Cul-de-sacs Public Utilities Renewal

## Paving Notice

November 14, 2019

Dear Residents,

Collier County is pleased to announce that the second and final layer of pavement is scheduled to be completed on Conners Avenue, Seabee Avenue, Germain Avenue, Seagull Avenue, Vanderbilt Drive from 101<sup>st</sup> to 106<sup>th</sup> Avenues and the west end of 103<sup>rd</sup> Avenue.

**When: Tuesday, November 19 and Wednesday, November 20, 2019**

**Construction schedule is subject to weather and field conditions.**

**Paving schedule changes will be posted to [www.CollierPUR.com](http://www.CollierPUR.com); no additional notices will be sent.**

**Right-of-Way must be cleared of any vehicles and property.**

### IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Paving activities will start at 7:00 a.m.
- Streets will be closed to **all** traffic to accommodate full-width paving which provides a better end-product.
- Each street will be closed while it is being paved and will be re-opened once its paving is complete.
- Please give yourself extra time to get in and out of your street while Vanderbilt Drive is being worked on.
- Emergency vehicles only will be given access.
- If a personal vehicle is on the road or in the right-of-way after 7:00 a.m. on paving day, the contractor will tow the vehicle at the owner's expense. Personal property in the right-of-way will also be removed.
- Landscaping trucks, construction trucks or any delivery trucks will not have access and will not be able to park on the road or turn into driveways during paving. Please notify them in advance.
- Paving will be cancelled and rescheduled if weather prohibits paving activities as scheduled or for any unforeseen conditions.

Some residents may notice tire marks on their driveways from the fresh asphalt. These marks are unavoidable and will fade away after approximately 3 to 4 months. Residents may want to take precautionary measures to minimize tire marks. Collier County will not clean or replace driveways due to tire marking. Minimizing traffic will result in a better end product and fewer tire marks.
