Dear residents of Palm River Area 4:

The Collier County Public Utilities Renewal project team is pleased to invite you to a Neighborhood Information Meeting about the replacement of the potable water infrastructure and installation of new wastewater collection system in the Cocohatchee Estates neighborhood. The project was approved by the Board of County Commissioners on July 23, 2024.

Enclosed with this letter is the Right of Entry (ROE) form that must be received by Collier County Real Property Management before the contractor starts the project. You are receiving two ROE forms, one distributed door-to-door and another copy via regular mail. Please return just one. Property owners who do not sign the ROE form in a timely manner will be responsible for the costs to install the grinder pump station, connect to the wastewater system and abandon the septic system, in addition to permitting and impact fees associated with this work.
